Life at Thorpe Lea

- School Day: Gates open 8:40–8:55 am; collection 3:15–3:25 pm.
- Nursery Sessions: Flexible 15- and 30-hour options.
- Uniform: Smart, practical and worn with pride.
- Meals: Healthy lunches available; free for Reception, Year 1 and Year 2. Packed lunches must be nut-free.
- Communication: Parent evenings, reports, newsletters, workshops and daily contact opportunities.



Early Years

Our Nursery and Reception provide a warm, stimulating start for children aged 3–4. Learning is play-based, creative and tailored to each child's needs. Our spacious classrooms and outdoor areas allow children to explore, experiment and grow in confidence.

Key Stages 1 & 2

From Year 1 to Year 6, children follow a broad and engaging curriculum based on the National Curriculum. English and maths are taught daily, alongside science, history, geography, computing, art, music, PE and more. We enrich learning through workshops, themed days and educational visits, including a residential trip in Year 6.

We place great emphasis on communication, creativity and problem-solving, equipping children with essential life skills.

Beyond the Classroom

- A wide range of clubs (sports, cheerleading, choir, gardening, coding and more).
- Breakfast Club from 7:40 am.
- School trips, performances and special events.
- Strong links with the local church, Royal Holloway University and the wider community.
